In order to establish your eligibility for free NHS treatment you may be asked to provide **at least one** document from each category below.

Acceptable Documents

Proof of identity:

applicable □ EU or Swiss National Identity Photocard □ Valid armed forces or police photographic identity card	Agency (BRP or BRC which must have been valid at point of treatment) Application Registration Card (ARC
□ Valid photographic driving licence	card) for patients who are claiming asylum
If your entry to the UK is dependent on a spouse or you are a family member of an EU national, then please also provide their documents as above (plus a copy of any marriage certificate if sponsored by your spouse)	

Proof of address:

(The following documents can be used as proof of your current address and should be dated within the last 3 months or if appropriate prove your address at point of treatment)

□ Council tax (current year)	 Notification letter from Department for Work and Pensions or HM Revenue & Customs confirming your right to benefits, state pension or your tax coding
 Original mortgage statement from recognised lender
